**Sub: Aarogyasri Health Care Trust – Guidelines for follow up
Services by the hospital under the Scheme – Reg.**

* * * * *

Rajiv Aarogyasri Scheme aims at providing coverage for follow-up services where specifically needed, so as to gain optimum benefit from the Surgery/Therapy and to avoid complications by providing system/disease specific package for one year follow-up for consultation, investigations, drugs etc. Follow-up treatment shall be entirely cashless to the patient and will start on 11th day after the discharge and will continue for one year from the first availed date. **Patients who underwent Surgery/ Therapy (for which 125 follow-up packages are available) prior, but not yet availed follow-up medicines till date are also eligible to avail the follow-up services, starting from the first availed date till one year. The same may be claimed by hospitals accordingly.**

125 packages and respective guidelines were formulated for follow up services by the Trust under the scheme (Annexure I). It may also be noted that the Government, Trust and Insurer is taking all necessary steps to motivate all treated and eligible patients to avail follow-up packages and these measures are being intensified during the months of June-2010 and July-2010.

On behalf of the Trust I request your hospital to extend the benefit of follow-up packages available to all patients as per the follow-up policy of the Scheme.
