

AAROGYASRI HEALTH CARE TRUST

The 18th Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Aarogyasri Health Care Trust was held on 01.10.2016 at 12.00 P.M at Indian Institute of Public Health (IIPH) under the Chairmanship of Dr. C. Laxma Reddy, Hon'ble Minister for Health Medical & Family Welfare, Telangana State. Sri. Rajeshwar Tiwari, I.A.S., Principal Secretary to Govt., Health, Medical & Family Welfare Dept, Dr. Budda Prakash M. Jyothi, I.A.S., Commissioner of Health & Family Welfare Dept., Dr. Ramani, Director of Medical Education Dept., and I/c. Commissioner, Telangana Vaidya Vidhana Parishad and other official members have attended the meeting. The list of members of the Board of Trust who were present is appended. Leave of Absence was granted to those who could not attend.

As per Bye-law 13(a) of Deed of Trust, the quorum required for the Board Meeting is four (4). Seven (7) Trustees including the Vice-Chairman and Ex- Officio Executive Vice – Chairman have attended the meeting and there was quorum.

The Chief Executive Officer, Aarogyasri Health Care Trust and Secretary of the Board of Trustees welcomed the members on behalf of the Chairman.

The Chief Executive Officer & Secretary of the Board briefed the Board of Trustees the developments that have taken place from 17th Meeting of the Board of Trustees on 22.02.2016 till the 18th Meeting of Board of Trustees on 01.10.2016. He briefed the actions taken on the Resolutions passed by the Board in the earlier Meeting (17th Meeting of Board of Trustees) held on 22.02.2016 as indicated in the 'Action Taken Report'.

The Board approved the 'Action Taken Report' relating to the Resolutions passed by the Board in the 17th Meeting of Board of Trustees held on 22.02.2016.

The following items, as per Agenda circulated, were considered by the Board of Trustees and decision taken thereon as under:

I. ITEMS FOR APPROVAL:

1. Enhancement of remuneration to BPO support staff of M/s. MD India Network Pvt. Ltd., and M/s. Medi Assist :-

The Health Advisors of 104 SK are demanding for enhancement of remuneration as per orders issued by the Government of Telangana vide G.O.Ms.No.14, Finance (HRM-I) Dept., Dt: 19.02.2016. The Board have examined the existing remuneration of Health Advisors including EHS Executives, 104 Seva Kendram working through M/s. MD India Network Pvt. Ltd., and support staff of M/s. Medi Assist working in Head Office of Trust and Operations Wing. In the said G.O. remuneration to the Outsourcing/Contract staff has been enhanced.

It is observed that staff working through M/s. MD India Network Pvt. Ltd and M/s. Medi Assist are on Business Process Outsourcing method as per guidelines issued in G.O.Rt.No.2246, Finance (SMPC) Dept., Dt:07.06.2007 and not on functionaries outsourcing method. Hence, the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.14, Financial (HRM-I) Dept., Dt:19.02.2016 are applicable to the staff working on functionaries outsourcing method and not to the staff working on Business Process Outsourcing method (functions outsourcing method).

Further, the Board have observed that the present remuneration of Health Advisors including EHS Executives of 104 SK is not commensurating with their responsibilities. The remuneration of other category of posts in 104 SK are on par with the remuneration of equal category in the Trust.

It is also observed that Executives and Team Leaders working through M/s. Medi Assist are getting different remuneration though they are discharging similar duties/functions.

The Board of Trustees have examined the request of Health Advisors and decided to enhance the remuneration of Health Advisor including EHS Executives only working in Telangana wing of 104 SK on par with Data Entry Operator category/post as ordered in G.O.Ms.No.14, Finance (HRM-I) Dept., Dt:19.02.2016 i.e. from existing Rs.10,000/- to Rs.15,000/- per month, though they are working on Business Process Outsourcing method. The remuneration of other category of posts in 104 SK will remain same.

The Board of Trustees has also decided to fix the remuneration of Executives working through M/s. Medi Assist on par with Data entry Operator category/post as ordered in G.O.Ms.No.14, Finance (HRM-I) Dept., Dt:19.02.2016 i.e. Rs.15,000/- per month.

It is also decided to fix remuneration of Team Leaders working through M/s. Medi. Assist on par with Data Processing Officer Category/post as ordered in G.O.Ms.No.14,Finance(HRM-I) Dept., Dt: 19.02.2016 i.e. Rs. 17,500/- per month.

The Board has decided to adopt equal remuneration for same work policy and Functionaries Outsourcing Method for engaging staff in the Trust and Operation wing except 104 SK in addition to existing Contract method.

It is also decided to continue the Functions Outsourcing method (BPO) in respect of 104 SK.

Resolution No. 314/2016 : By the authority under bye-laws of Trust Deed, the Board approved the following: -

(i). Enhancement of remuneration of Health Advisors (including EHS Executives) only working in Telangana wing, 104 SK on par with Data Entry Operator Category/

post as ordered in G.O. Ms.No.14, Finance (HRM-I) Dept., Dt:19.02.2016 i.e. Rs. 10,000/- to Rs. 15,000/- per month.

(ii). Enhancement of remuneration of Health Advisors shall come into force w.e.f. 01.10.2016.

(iii). Fixation of remuneration of Executives working through Ms/. Medi Assist on par with Data Entry Operator category/post as ordered in G.O.Ms.No.14, Finance (HRM-I) Dept., Dt: 19.02.2016 i.e. Rs. 15,000/- per month.

(iv). Fixation of remuneration of Team Leaders working through M/s. Medi Assist on par with Data Processing Officer category/post as ordered in G.O.Ms. No.14, Finance (HRM-I) Dept., Dt: 19.02.2016 i.e. Rs. 17,500/- per month.

(v). The fixed remuneration of Executives and Team Leaders mentioned at item (iii) & (iv) above shall come into force w.e.f. 01.01.2017.

(vi). Adopt equal remuneration for same work policy and Functionaries Outsourcing Method for engaging staff in the Trust and Operation wing except 104 SK.

(vii). Continue the Functions Outsourcing method (BPO) in respect of 104 SK.

2. Remuneration of Package Process under Aarogyasri Health Scheme & Employee Health Scheme.

The Board have examined the proposal of revision of package prices under Aarogyasri Health Scheme & Employee Health Scheme and observed that the existing package prices were ordered in 2013 and for the last three years there is a increase in prices of medical inputs. The Networx Hospitals are repeated the Government to revise the package price.

Resolution No. 315/2016: By the authority under bye-laws of Trust Deed, the Board permitted to take up the exercise of revision of package prices under Aarogyasri and EHS Scheme.

3. Empanelment of Hospitals of Andhra Pradesh:

It is observed that the patients hailing from Telangana State particularly Districts of Mahabubnagar, Nalgonda and Khammam frequently visit the NWHs of Andhra Pradesh, for reasons of proximity, convenience, easy accessibility and various other factors. Further it is to submit that above said districts have national highway and accident prone areas. In order to facilitate the Telangana State patients for treatment in Andhra Pradesh NWHs and Andhra Pradesh patients at the Telangana NWHs the proposal of MOU with AP Govt. is considered.

Resolution No. 316/2016 : By the authority under bye-laws of Trust Deed, the Board permitted to enter into a “ Memorandum of under Standing” between Telangana State Networx Hospitals and Andhra Pradesh Stat Networx Hospitals for treating of vice – versa patients.

4. Inclusion of Organ Transplantation Surgery under Aarogyasri Scheme:

Chief Executive Officer, Aarogyasri has explained the Board that series of meetings were conducted with the Jeevandan Officials and Specialists to obtain the package prices of following Transplantations including immunosuppressive therapy.

- Cadaver Heart Transplantation Surgery
- Cadaver Lung Transplantation Surgery
- Cadaver Heart & Lung Transplantation Surgery
- Post Cadaver/live Kidney Transplantation immunosuppressive therapy
- Bone marrow Transplantation Surgery
- Live liver Transplantation Surgery
- Post Cadaver/live Liver Transplantation immunosuppressive therapy

It was also informed the Board that the package price for above Organ Transplantation Surgery done by obtaining clinical inputs from the Specialists and as per the AHCT Package Pricing methodology adopted for Final Therapy Prices and SSR given in Annexure to G.O.Ms.No.87, HM&FW(M2)Dept., Dt: 27.06.2013. The package prices are listed in the following table: -

Resolution No. 317/2016: By the authority under bye-laws of Trust Deed, the Board has agreed for inclusion of above Organ Transplantation Surgeries with following instructions:

- A. Board has approved Post Live/Cadaver Kidney Transplant Immunosuppression Therapy per month, after initial 6 months for life long with package price for Rs. 9,500/- per month.
- B. Board has directed to reserve Allogeneic Stem Cell Transplantation and Autologous Stem Cell Transplantation procedures to Government Hospitals initially for NIMS & MNJ Hospitals.
- C. Board has directed to open Cadaver Transplantation Surgeries including Immunosuppressive Therapy for Government and Private Hospitals.
- D. Board has directed to include Immunosuppressive Therapy in Transplantations Surgeries package and issue guidelines for implementation of Immunosuppressive Therapy by the NWH responsible for surgery.
- E. Board has directed to draft guidelines for repeated utilization of Complications Packages under Transplantation Surgeries.

5. Sanction of amounts exceeding Rs. 2.00 lakhs for Renal Transplant (both Live and Cadaver) and Post Transplant Immunosuppressive Therapy and ALL & AML under Aarogyasri Scheme :

The Board has reviewed the item for enhancement of financial limit of Rs.2.00 Lakhs under Aarogyasri Scheme for Kidney Transplant (both Live and Cadaver)& Post Transplant Immunosuppressive Therapy and Cancer Treatment for ALL & AML under Aarogyasri Scheme.

(1). Renal Transplantation Surgery:

Under Aarogyasri, the coverage amount is Rs. 2.00 Lakhs per family per year. It is proposed to utilize the coverage amount pertaining to the next financial year for meeting expenditure which exceeds Rs.2.00 lakh in the current financial year in the cases mentioned above.

As per the 16th Board Resolution No.268/2014, AHCT prepared draft Guidelines for enhancement of financial coverage under Aarogyasri Scheme for Renal Transplantation and Oncology procedures (ALL & AML) and forwarded to Government for approval vide AHCT Lr.No.AST/5808-2/P&C/Guidelines/2014, dt:20.12.2014. Orders are awaited from the Government.

Draft Guidelines are given below:-

- Cases eligible for enhancement of financial coverage
- Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia (ALL) and Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (AML) conditions requiring treatment under Medical and Radiation Oncology and Renal transplant surgery with follow up treatment cases are eligible for enhancement of financial coverage.
- Guidelines for enhancement of amount
- The approved enhanced amount will be utilized within the current financial year.
- Enhancement facility shall be given to a single beneficiary availing above mentioned Oncology conditions and Renal Transplantation procedures.

Resolution No. 318/2016: By the authority under the Bye-laws of Trust Deed, Board has agreed for enhancement of financial limit of Rs.2.00 Lakhs under Aarogyasri Scheme for Kidney Transplant Treatment and Cancer Treatment for ALL & AML mentioned above subject to the following conditions:-

- The approved enhanced amount will be utilized within the current financial year.
- Enhancement facility shall be given to a single beneficiary availing above mentioned Oncology conditions and Renal Transplantation procedures.

6. **Deletion of recommended Dental Procedures under Employees Health Scheme:**

The Specialists Committee analysed the data of utilization of the dental procedures under EHS and reviewed procedures and packages under Dental category. The committee recommended to delete 73 Dental Procedures out of existing 145 Dental procedures under EHS which are duplicated, out dated and cosmetic dental procedures and it was observed that there is chance of moral hazard during utilization.

Resolution No. 319/2016: By the authority under the Bye-laws of Trust Deed, Board has agreed for deletion of 73 recommended Dental Procedures under Employees Health Scheme.

7. Rationalization of S18 Dental Package under EHS and JHS:

Keeping in view the present circumstances in implementation of Employees Health Scheme, Board have discussed the proposal of fixing of ceiling amount i.e. Rs.60,000/- per family, per year for dental category (S18) for EHS and JHS beneficiaries and decided to defer the proposal.

Resolution No. 320/2016: By the authority under the Bye-laws of Trust Deed, Board has deferred the proposal of fixing of ceiling amount i.e. Rs.60,000/- per family, per year for dental category (S18) for EHS and JHS beneficiaries.

8. Tripartite agreement for implementation of STEMI India Project in Medak District:

The Board has reviewed the implementation of STEMI India Project in Medak District as pilot project and examined the proposal of constitution of Steering Committee under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to Government, HM & FW Dept., to operate the STEEMI Project throughout Telangana State. The Board directed the CEO to refer the matter to Government.

Resolution No. 321/2016: By the authority under the bye-laws of Trust Deed, Board has directed to refer the proposal of constitution of Steering Committee for STEMI India project.

9. Further extension of TCS Service Contract with AHCT.

The Board has observed that selection on new service provider for the maintenance and development of IT application of Aarogyasri Health Care Trust and Employees Health Scheme will take some more time. Hence, it is decided to extend the existing contract of service provider i.e. TCS on same terms and conditions upto 31.03.2017 (or) till finalization of new service provider, whichever is earlier.

Resolution No.322/2016: By the authority under the bye-laws of Trust Deed, Board has extended the contract period of Tata Consultancy Services upto 31.03.2017 (or) till finalization of new service provider, whichever is earlier.

10. Health Camp Policy

The Board has observed that conduct of Health Camps in the districts to popularize the Aarogyasri Scheme is no more required as the said scheme got much popularity due to the efforts made by the AHCT earlier. Hence, it is decided to conduct of Health Camps be dispensed with.

Resolution No. 323/2016: By the authority under the Bye-laws of Trust Deed, the Board ordered to dispense with Health Camp Policy.
