Sub: Renewal of Rajiv Aarogyasri Community Health Insurance Scheme (Aarogyasri I and Aarogyasri II) in 3 districts of Srikakulam, Mahboobnagar and Anantapur- Phase I (3rd Renewal) from 00:00 hrs of 05.04.2010 and 5 districts of Karimangar, Medak, Kadapa, Prakasam and Nellore - Phase III (2nd Renewal) from 00:00 hrs of 15.04.2010 - intimation to Network Hospitals

We are pleased to inform you that Govt. of AP/ Aarogyasri Health Care Trust has renewed the Rajiv Aarogyasri Community Health insurance scheme (Aarogyasri I and Aarogyasri II) for a period of one year in Srikakulam, Mahboobnagar and Anantapur - Phase I (3rd Renewal) from 00:00 hrs of 05.04.2010 and Karimnagar, Medak, Kadapa, Prakasam and SPS Nellore - Phase III (2nd Renewal) from 00:00 hrs of 15.04.2010 as the present Rajiv Aarogyasri I & Aarogyasri II schemes being implemented through insurance company are coming to an end on mid night of 04.04.10 for Phase I (2nd Renewal) and midnight of 14.04.10 for Phase III (1st Renewal). Star Health and Allied Insurance Company Limited is selected as insurer through competitive bidding process for these districts for one year.

The salient features of the scheme are

- Rajiv Aarogyasri I & II Schemes are renewed for these 3 districts of Phase I (3rd Renewal) for 942 procedures (352 procedures of Aarogyasri I and 590 procedures of Aarogyasri II) through Insurance Company.
- Rajiv Aarogyasri I & II Schemes are renewed for these 5 districts of Phase III (2nd Renewal) for 942 procedures (352 procedures of Aarogyasri I and 590 procedures of Aarogyasri II) through Insurance Company.
- The renewal policy period of Phase I (3rd Renewal) will be from 00.00 hrs of 05.04.2010 to 24.00 hrs of 04.04.2011 in the districts of Srikakulam, Mahboobnagar and Anantapur.
- The renewal policy period of Phase III (2nd Renewal) will be from 00.00 hrs of 15.04.2010 to 24.00 hrs of 14.04.2011 in the districts of Karimnagar, Medak, Kadapa, Prakasam and SPS Nellore.

In view of the above it may be noted that the scheme will continue uninterruptedly in these 8 districts. All the arrangements have been made for smooth transition of scheme and to facilitate hospitals to send on-line pre authorizations and claim without any break.

However all the pre-authorisations obtained till expiry of Phase I (2nd Renewal) i.e till 24.00 hrs of 04.04.10 i.e., will have 30 days run-off period i.e., till 24:00 hrs of 04.05.10 for performing and updating the surgeries, and of them, the surgeries which could not be performed by 24:00 hrs of 04.05.10 will get cancelled and fresh pre-authorisations under the renewed scheme can be obtained, hence the hospital authorities shall provide the treatment to the patients uninterruptedly. Similarly all

the pre-authorisations obtained till expiry of Phase III (1st Renewal) i.e till 24.00 hrs of 14.04.10 i.e., will have 30 days run-off period i.e., till 24:00 hrs of 14.05.10 for performing and updating the surgeries, and of them, the surgeries which could not be performed by 24:00 hrs of 14.05.10 will get cancelled and fresh pre-authorisations under the renewed scheme can be obtained, hence the hospital authorities shall provide the treatment to the patients uninterruptedly

With regard to the claims pertaining to the policies of Phase I(2nd Renewal) which comes to an end from 24.00 hrs of 04.04.2010 and phase III(1st Renewal) which comes to an end from 24.00 hrs of 14.04.2010, we request you to follow the articles of the MOU given below for claim processing.

- ⇒ **23.3** The Provider agrees to submit all the claims for the surgeries/Treatments performed within 60 days from the date of discharge of Patient.
- ⇒ **23.4** The provider agrees that for all the claims for which preauthorization is obtained by the end of this agreement period, surgeries/Treatment will be done with in 30 days of expiry of this agreement and claim will be raised as per clause **23.3** above

Hence all the network hospitals are requested to continue to extend their services to all the eligible beneficiaries belonging to these 8 districts under the scheme. The MOU of Phase I (3rd Renewal) and Phase III (2nd Renewal) will be available in the online application of the respective hospitals. The hospitals are requested to download the MOU and print on stamp paper (Rs 100/-) and the signed copies of the MOU's are to be uploaded in the Aarogyasri portal in hospital information in the hospital login and the hard copies are to be sent to following address.
